Our January speaker will be the extremely entertaining and informative Tony Millet. He will be speaking on orchid culture and hybridizing. Believe me, you will learn a lot.



### Our January Speaker Tony Millet "Hybridizing, sowing orchid seed and growing out seedlings"

Tony Millet's mother started his growing career at a very young age, teaching him to grow everything from seed. While growing up in Brooklyn, NY, he began his orchid growing career by delving into cool, intermediate and warm types of orchids. Tony's experience of growing in underground cold frames to an above ground greenhouse set the tone for his new semi retirement lathe house Florida

style growing. The early childhood experience of germinating from seed set the tone for his own orchid hybridizing program.

He breeds and grows unusual hybrids in the large Cattleya alliance, He also performs all flasking activities, lectures and teaches. He is an AOS student judge. Many of Tony's hybrids have been AOS awarded. His present growing goal is to impart warm tolerance to some of the cooler growing colorful hadro laelias.

His presentation will focus on Hybridizing in a hands on friendly session keeping it very simple using every day words and concepts. Some audience participation.





